

## **Recipe Book**

### **Project Instructions:**

#### **A. In the classroom**

- Look at recipes and understand the structure of recipe writing
- Write a recipe that you enjoy preparing or eating/is important to you in some way/from your country of origin
- Write it under the following headings: Title, Ingredients, Method, Preparation Time and Serves (how many people?)
  - Plan your work and discuss it with teacher
  - Write a draft and get it reviewed by teacher
  - Edit your work and write a good copy
- Write a short introduction about yourself at the bottom of the recipe(Country of origin/memories associated with the recipe/cooking experience)
- Get your plan and draft reviewed by teacher
- Work in groups:
  1. Design a front page
  2. Prepare a content page
  3. List the abbreviations used in recipes and give the expanded forms
- Organise the printing of the recipe book

#### **B. In the Computer Lab**

- Open Microsoft Word 2003 and type your edited version of the Recipe
- Insert a suitable picture from the internet (refer to given instructions)
- Insert a page border (refer to given instructions)
- Insert a header (refer to given instructions)

#### **C. Presentation**

- Prepare your recipes and bring it to class
- Present your work to the class
